# GOOD TO KNOW

## A FEW THINGS THAT SAVE FAMILIES A PHONE CALL



### THE SCHOOL DAY

- Doors open at 7:45 AM.
- In cold or wet weather the gym and auditorium open at 7:30 AM.
- First class begins at 7:55 AM. Students arriving after that are marked tardy.



### ABSENCES & EARLY DISMISSAL

- Report absences and late arrivals in the Genesis Parent Portal before 7:30 AM, with a reason.
- Students leaving early must be signed out at the Main Office.
- Makeup work is due in the number of days equal to the absence.



### PHONES & DEVICES

- Cell phones and smartwatches are not permitted during the school day. They stay off, in lockers.
- CMS is moving to shared classroom Chromebooks rather than individual take-home devices.



### VISITORS & VOLUNTEERS

- Bring a photo ID every time you enter the building.
- Sign in through the Main Office and follow all school security procedures.
- Allow extra time for drop-off and pick-up during the first weeks of school.



### FOOD AT PTO EVENTS

- All snacks require nurse approval.
- Full ingredient lists must go to the school nurses at least three weeks before an event.
- Ingredient labels for packaged items should be available to parents on request.



### STAY AHEAD OF IT

- Read the Student Handbook with your child early in the year.
- Keep emergency contacts current in Genesis.
- Encourage students to check Google Classroom and talk to teachers directly.
